- You keep all your civil rights




Human rights in Norway

- Solitary confinement in prison










Forecast - number og women in prison 2023



Prognosene tar ikke høyde for endringer i lovverket med tanke på økt bruk av elektronisk kontroll og økt gjennomføringstid for elektronisk kontroll. Dette vil kunne påvirke etterspørselen etter fengselsplasser i negativ forstand.

- Estimated that women counts for 5,5% – 6 % of the prison population
- Alternativ to custody 4-5 places
- Given an estimate that 6% of the prison population are women in 2030




Wayback Mapping - Major Findings

- Prisons for women are old, outdated and not built to purpose
- The proximity principle not valid for women.
- Lack of adequate health service
- Sound through the walls (lack of isolation)
- Not defined low security and high security
- Space and not where you belong to, defines where they serve your sentence




The research

- Changes over time??









Challenges, selfharming, suicide attempts, security cells 2022

Cases of selfharming and suicide attempts by month

Suicide attempts.

- 88 totally,
- 57 of them are women

Selharming


- 265 cases
- 212 are women
- To save lifes, women are placed in security cells

Medical restraint (belts)

• 43 cases, 42 are women

Security cells

• 30 % are women






Solution


- Lack of knowledge education
